

ESN members are at the core of ESN's work.


Members can participate in ESN's annual conference, seminars, working groups, training programmes, country visits, and other projects.





Social Services Helpdesk on EU Funds

The **Social sErviceShelpdesK** aims to help managing authorities to use EU Funds on social services and public authorities to access to the grants







Reticulate

Reticulate aims at piloting an integrated system of social inclusion support through a 'one-stop shop' model for people furthest from the labour market.

xEITU

xEITU, will test a new model of employment and social services coordination to transform the regional minimum income to a new model of social inclusion support.





Side by Side

A CERV project, with the overarching goal to increase the knowledge on adequate responses within social services on effective integrated mechanisms to prevent violence against children (VAC) and to reinforce child protection services in the Member States.



No-Limit

No-Limit is a mobility Erasmus project on adult education operators supporting the labor inclusion of people with mental health problems and severe mental illness







ACE Project aims to support home care ecosystems in the North Sea Region, and through the adaptation of care service providers to upcoming technologies.



Learning and Innovation LABS

The project aims to develop & test a new transferable 'Learning & Innovation Lab' model to the delivery of more integrated and person-centred health and social care services to vulnerable client groups.





European Social Innovation Catalyst Fund

SISWEC – Streightening the skills of social workers in a Europe in crisis.

The European Social Innovation Catalyst Fund (ESIC-Fund) will raise new funding, integrate existing funding streams, and provide cutting-edge capacity building to support approximately 40 social innovations to scale across the fields of the EU Missions.

SISWEC aims to contribute to the improvement of professional university training in the field of social work to prepare the future of social workers. The general objective is to improve the offer of university training in initial and continuing education by updating the knowledge and training methods of social workers.







Eldicare 2.0

The project aims to strengthen the cooperation among sectoral partners on elderly care, as well as to update the occupational profiles and competencies of professionals in the elderly caregiving sector, by providing a sectoral skills long-term strategy that will tackle skills gaps on the labor market and anticipate future skills.

The project aims to improve the well-being of people living in care homes in two regions in Spain, Asturias, and Euskadi.
